#### **Your Vote Counts!**







#### **American Political Parties**


Democrats and Republicans are the two largest American political parties in the US. They hold almost all of the seats in the Senate and in the House of Representatives. Democrats and Republicans have different ideas on many important issues. Many other people are Unenrolled Independents or belong to smaller political parties like the Libertarians or Rainbow Greens. This worksheet will focus on the differences between Republicans and Democrats.



(By the way, "Republican" is often represented with a picture of an elephant, while a picture of a donkey is sometimes used to mean "Democrat!")

#### Democrat vs Republican

There are many differences between the parties. The Democratic Party is left-leaning, liberal and usually associated with progressiveness. The Republican Party, is right-leaning, traditional and associated with economic freedom and with the ideal of "survival of the fittest".

Every four years, citizens in the United States vote in the Presidential Election. The next Presidential Election will be in 2020. For the past 165 years, the US President has been either a Republican or a Democrat.



President Donald Trump is a Republican who was elected in 2016.



President Barack Obama is a Democrat who was elected in 2008 and again in 2012.

## **Taxes** are money citizens need to pay in order to fund the government and provide services for the people.

Republicans often believe that rich and poor should pay the same taxes (and possibly receive tax cuts). Even if large tax cuts may lead to less money collected by the government, Republicans believe that, after tax reductions, rich people and entrepreneurs would be more likely to invest and create jobs. Republicans also oppose raising minimum wages as such increase could hurt small businesses.

Democrats often believe in raising taxes for the upper class and lowering taxes for the lower and middle class to allow the government to boost spending for social programs for people who are poor.



Rich people should pay more taxes than poor people so that people without money may get more help they need to survive.

Democrats are likely to be in favor of more strict gun laws but recognize that the Second Amendment is an important part of the American tradition and that the right to use firearms should be preserved. They support an assault weapons ban and believe that the government should make the background check system stronger.



# **Voter ID Laws** are laws that say what kind of identification is needed when a person shows up to vote on election day.





### **Midterm Elections 2018**



**Who:** American Citizens, like you, who are over eighteen years old and who have already registered to vote in this election.





What: Electing a state Governor, Senator, Representatives and other government officials. Midterm elections happen on years that take place in the middle of the President's 4 year term, so the President is not on the ballot. There are also 3 ballot questions that were proposed by citizens who want to change laws in Massachusetts.





Where: Midterm elections are taking place in every state in America. Most voters will go to a polling place in the city or town where they live, but some voters will mail in absentee ballots they requested and have already received in the mail.





When: Election Day is Tuesday, November 6 2018, but many cities like Somerville have polling places that are already open for early voting.





Why: Voting is a crucial part of living in a Democracy. If we don't vote, then we are giving away our voice to say what kind of country we want to live in. Midterm elections are very important because the Senators and Representatives we elect will have a huge impact on what sort of laws and policies the President will be able to pass. Since President Trump is a Republican, Republican politicians are likely to support his positions and turn his ideas for America into laws. If more Democrats are elected, it will be much harder for President Trump to turn his ideas into laws.
